Hh. Thought I'd brighten up this paper w/ a red pen.
Sometimes I get sick of plain white paper. b/c, I just can't tell
you how happy I am to get your letter today. I wasn't expecting
it cause I just got one yesterday. I must say, your timing
was great. I'm sorry for my depressing letter of yesterday
I was so blue for you - I was miserable. I'm finding out
just how much I appreciate you and all that you are. All
our really good times together (which is most of the time) come
to mind. I was really bad most of the day today - depressed
that is. Carolyn had asked me to go to the movies with her
tonight, but I decided I was too much of a mess to go - she
probably wouldn't have had a good time. But then I ran after
work-around Texarkana 3 times!! Can you believe it? I just
kept going & going and I felt really good. I think I'm
getting in better shape cause I wasn't really ever sick.
Maybe it's my iron pills (they're shaped like nails). They have
300 mg of iron in & if 2mg gets absorbed that will be good →
say Dr Carpenter. I think my running helped put
me in a more lovable mood (I play a lot while I run).
I usually have a good time when I run - I get a lot of things
straight out in my head. So being in a better mood - I
came home & there was a letter from my late on my
desk like I said good-bye to it. All I had to do is
read that you love me & are thinking about me and I
felt much better. Thanks!!

I'm so happy for you. Sounds like you are growing
so close to the Lord. I'm anxiously awaiting our shaking
times together. I long for that. When you come home I'll
never stop hearing & listening to all that
you're learning & experiencing. I can't wait! I know
that the Lord is using & will continue to use you. I'm
praying confidently for that. Henry, the Lord is definitely

with you and will never fail you. I'm sure as you connect, he will bring many things which you learned to your remembrance.

Hen - tell Viscous that I said hi. Also greet Dwight for me. I'm glad you got to ride a horse. It would be a scary thing, but Hen if you can drive a motorcycle (and you can) you can ride a horse. I don't know how true that is though. Are you sure from it? The heard horse back riders got gone. How many horses do they have up there? What was your horses name? I remember those 2 horses we saw out alone on the grass & we stopped to look at them. They are beautiful animals. You are beautiful, Henry.

Today it is 95° and it's beautiful. When I ran today - I really sweated. You don't even have to be doing much of anything to sweat today. I guess your weather & our weather are pretty much the same from all that you wrote.

He has had too few victories in this area of my life. At work, things are always changing, my schedule for example - you plan to go work with a patient & a doctor is in with them or they're in x-ray or they're letting & it throws your whole schedule off. That is sometimes enough to get me impatient, but I feel that the Lord is really working there with me - cause it doesn't really bother me anymore. Also today I went in to walk a patient. It normally takes ~45 minutes to walk 200'. We had just started to walk when Dr's came in to talk with him, then they left & a nurse came in for vitals. Then a lab tech came in to take a 3:30 sugar & she dropped tubes on the bed.

Normally I would have said to her 'He'll be back here after his walk for you to take blood'. But I could tell the Lord was telling me to yield and let her do her wish (she seemed really busy) and he even gave me a good attitude (I didn't feel disgruntled). I need to let the Lord use me & work through me; but I fail so often.

I like the leaves you're sending me - esp. the one in your last letter (I don't know from what kind of tree it is). Your article is very helpful - thank you for sending it for me to use. You really get onto the word deep. That's good.
