

Getting ready for Oct 21 missionary conference capsule (mini-conference) for the banquet instead of having a big meal - we're having 1 bowl of soup per person and then asking for donations for 'World Relief' - because we have so much and other people in the world are starving. At church tonight, a lot of people asked about you. They always do. So many people are praying for you. In fact - tonight on the prayer sheets we got, your name was on it for prayer & your school. So, if you have an extra great week - it's cause so many are praying for you.

Prayer meeting has been really terrific. We sing a song and then have a short word from Pastor Dave, then split up into prayer groups (about 4 per group) We each go to a different part of the church and we have about 45 minutes for prayer. It's now prayer meeting and you know real close to those you pray with. By the way, how's your prayer time with your roomate coming along? That's such a significant time. You grow so close. I long to be able to pray with you soon, Henry.

Something I've started to do, is during my morning prayer time (to have your schedule right there with me and pray about each class you'll be going to that day). I sure do wish you could be here to see them. I love you. It's a full moon tonight, too. I just washed my hair with Suave wild strawberry shampoo - how is it wild. Tonight, mom + daddy went to see Jews II - can you believe it?! Beth starts her first art class at Baum art school tonight - drawing class. Vicki's playing the piano now - she plays for hours + hours. I called Hackman's tonight and asked if they had 'morning has broken' and also music by John Fischer. So I guess on Sat. I'll go in and pick something out for Vicki + I to do on ~~Sat.~~ next Sunday night at church.

Cindy was able to observe total knee surgery. They're doing a new total knee prosthesis now (the past 2 patients) - they can bear not sooner and they are almost completely pain free. She said it was real interesting - she said she never realized how 'crude' orthopedic surgery was. It really is. They had some complications getting the prostheses to fit with the correct angles and all because the pt is so arthritic.

The surgery was suppose to take 2 hours, but it took 5 hours. She said it was a tense atmosphere - Dr O'Brien was getting disgusted with everyone because of the problems they had.
